Grandmaster Beard inherited the leadership of the Budoki Junari system when Professor Chambers retired in January 2006. He began his martial arts training in 1968 in the art of judo. He is a professor of special education at Jacksonville State University (AL) and oversees their jujutsu and judo club program.



Kenneth Lones

Sensei Lones holds traditional ranks in Karate, Jujutsu, and Kobudo. He also is an instructor of modern combative methods and the art of Escrima. He has experience at the National and International level as a competitor and coach to several title holders to include his son in both forms and fighting competition.



Carole Ivie- “10 Really Cool Things I’ve Stolen (and I’m not sorry)”

Professor Carole Ivie currently holds Hachidan in Jujitsu, Rokudan in Karate, Nidan in Judo, first level Eagle Claw Kung Fu, and Nidan in Yudo, as well as professorship with MYB, and grandmastership with MAUSA. Her philosophy of life: “Get over yourself and get out there. If you’re not learning, you’re not living.”



James Webster- “NunChaku Kata and Chanbarra Sparring”

Grandmaster James Webster began training in Karate at Master Phil Koeppel’s Karate School in Peoria, Illinois in 1974. He changed style of karate from Shorei Ryu to Shorin Ryu in 1985. Grandmaster Webster holds the rank of 8th Dan in Shorin Ryu Karate and 7th Dan in Okinawan Kobudo. He was inducted in the United States Martial Arts Hall of Fame in June 2011.



Tennis Smith- “Sword Techniques of Toyama Ryu”

Sensei Tennis Smith (yes, his real name) grew up in Decatur, Alabama. After a stint in the Air Force, he moved to California in 1984. He began the study of sword and jujitsu in 2000. He has had the honor of studying Toyama-Ryu Batto-Jitsu (sword) and Danzan-Ryu Aiki-Jujitsu with Professor Mike Esmailzadeh of Suigetsukan (www.suigetsukan.org) in Oakland, California. He holds the rank of Shodan in Danzan Ryu and Nidan in Toyama Ryu.



Jimmy Jackson- “Pressure Points”

Grandmaster Jackson holds ranks in multiple disciplines and styles of the martial arts. Over his forty-year martial arts journey, he has studied some twenty-nine different styles and disciplines of the martial arts. His search of a better way of doing things has been rewarded with ten different certified yudansha, (black belt ranks), four of which are master levels. All of this diverse training has led to the formulation of the “American Dragon Self-Defense System and the (Sogo) eclectic art of “Kuro Ryu Aiki Goshin Sen Jutsu”.
